



REACH-Declaration

The articles and materials offered in the shop are articles according to Article 3 number 3 of the REACH regulation and therefore not to be defined as a substance or mixture. In addition, no substances should be released from these materials under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. Thus, the articles offered by Metallbearbeitung Gerhard Maier Pfaffenhofen are not subject to the registration obligation of substances in products. Furthermore, according to the REACH regulation, no safety data sheets are required for these articles (see Article 31 of the REACH regulation).

For the delivery of the materials, qualified and trustworthy sources of supply are very important to us. We have known our suppliers for years. We have very high quality requirements that have to be met and are continuously monitored by.

The quality of the articles and materials we sell is very important to us in the interests of our customers. That is why we are in constant contact with our suppliers and constantly make sure that all relevant requirements are meticulously met.
